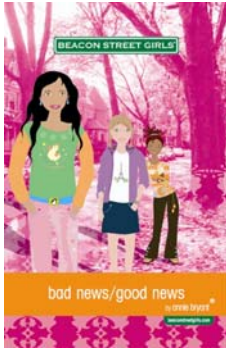




Writing Activity 1: Thank-You Notes
