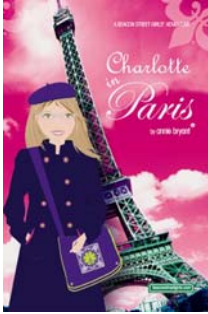


Research Activity 1: Famous Americans in Paris
