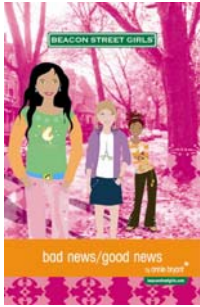


Research Activity 2: Parisian Landmarks
